## Frequently Asked Questions

**What counts for donating to [The Annual Fund](#)? Why does it matter?** Only donations made to The Annual Fund- SHARE generate DDF for districts that can then be used in district and global grants. District often require clubs to reach an average per capita giving of at least \$100 to be “grant qualified.” While only donations to SHARE generate DDF, contributions directed towards Areas of Focus count towards a club’s annual giving goal and per capita calculation.

**What donations earn [Paul Harris Recognition Points](#)?** Foundation Recognition Points are awarded for donations to The Annual Fund, Polio Plus, Disaster Relief, and approved Global Grants at a rate of one point per dollar.

**When is The Rotary Foundation month?** [November is TRF month.](#) It’s a great time to encourage your club members to make end-of-year donations and use PH points to match their gifts.

**Where can I find how many PH points my club or a member has?** Club Presidents and Club Rotary Foundation Chairs can run [Club Giving Reports](#) on my.rotary.org for up-to-date PH recognition levels.

**How can I transfer PH points to someone else?** PH Points can be transferred in transactions of at least 100 points at a time by completing the [Recognition and Transfer Request](#) form found on Rotary’s website.

**What does it mean to be “grant qualified” and what are the requirements?** This can vary between districts, so check with your DG or DRFC. Milestones might include giving to The Annual Fund, setting club goals, attend PETS, etc.

**What is the difference between my club or district’s foundation and The Rotary Foundation?** These are different entities. Only TRF provides DDF and approves District and Global Grants.
