Assistant Governor Roles & Responsibilities

- **Visit each club regularly**
- **Support in goal setting, resolving conflicts, meeting membership & financial requirements**
- **Liaison between clubs and district committees**
- **Assess and mentor clubs toward success**
- **Encourage clubs to be involved in district activities**
- **Help organize new clubs**
- **Keep the DG informed about club progress**
- **Stay up to date on RI initiatives**
